The aim of these groups is to provide an environment of high challenge to help disciple young people to grow in their Christian walk and to challenge them to apply Gods word to their lives. You as Parents can support by accessing the Sunday message being discussed in the group, reminding about Bible memorization, and obviously making sure your child is attending regularly. We do expect a high level of engagement and behaviour, and kindly ask young people to be

- 1) Respectful of people's homes and help with the tidy up**
- 2) Be there each week and punctual**
- 3) Listen well to the leaders during discussions**

The young people signing up to this must have made a commitment to follow Christ, the young people will be expected to commit for a year, and as part of this commitment for both the young person, and you as parents we ask you to sign below.
